RESOLUTION NO. N/A

RESOLUTION AMENDING THE RESOLUTION ADOPTED JANUARY 10, 2019 LEVYING AN ADDITIONAL ONE-FOURTH OF ONE PERCENT SALES AND USE TAX

WHEREAS, this board of county commissioners adopted a resolution levying an additional 0.25% sales and use taxes (the "2019 Taxes") on January 10, 2016 (the "Prior Resolution") as an emergency measure to (i) provide additional revenue to this county's General Fund for a continuing period of time commencing April 1, 2019, and (b) make the aggregate of all sales and use taxes levied by this county equal the maximum permitted by Ohio law (i.e., 1.50%); and

WHEREAS, this board of county commissioners has been advised that the Prior Resolution contained an error in that it referred to the 2019 Taxes as being levied pursuant to Ohio Revised Code ("ORC") Sections 5739.026 and 5741.023, respectively, instead of ORC Sections 5739.021 and 5741.021, respectively;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Gallia County, Ohio that (all the members thereof concurring) that:

SECTION 1. This board of county commissioners hereby finds and determines that:

- In adopting the Prior Resolution, it was this board's intention that the County levy the maximum aggregate amount of sales and use taxes permitted under ORC Sections 5739.021, 5739.026, 5741.021 and 5741.023 (i.e., 1.50%);
- The references in the Prior Resolution to such Sections 5739.026 and 5741.023 were a scrivener's error and by correcting such error as provided in this resolution, this board will:
 - be honoring its intention that an additional 0.25% tax is urgently needed for General Fund purposes for the reasons set forth in the Prior Resolution, regardless of the statutory provisions referred to therein;
 - avoid confusing this county's taxpayers who have been advised of the 2019 Taxes and their April 1, 2019 effective date through the public notices and hearings held prior to the adoption of the Prior Resolution and media reports; and
 - with the Ohio Tax Commissioner's consent, allow the 2019 Taxes to take effect on April
 1, 2019 as stated in the Prior Resolution, thereby allowing this county to address its
 financial needs resulting from the emergency conditions set out in the Prior Resolution at
 the earliest possible time;
 - o not adversely affect this county's taxpayers, since when compared to the alternative of starting over and going through the entire process of levying the 2019 Taxes, the sum of this county's sale and use taxes would be the same (i.e., the legal maximum of 1.50%);
 - o not adversely affect this county's ability to levy additional sales and use taxes since in any case, such 1.50% legal maximum under all the applicable sales and use tax statutes will have been exhausted; and
 - avoid the time, expense and fiscal distress due to lost tax revenue that redoing the proceedings for the 2019 Taxes would entail.
- SECTION 2. The references in the Prior Resolution to ORC Sections 5739.026 and 5741.023 are hereby amended to instead refer to ORC Sections 5739.021 and 5741.021, respectively.
 - SECTION 3. In all other respects, the Prior Resolution is hereby approved, ratified and confirmed.
- SECTION 4. The clerk of this board of county commissioners is directed to certify a copy of this resolution to the Ohio Tax Commissioner for receipt as soon as practicable after its adoption.
- SECTION 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this board of county commissioners concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this board of county commissioners, that all deliberations of this board of county commissioners and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22.
 - SECTION 6. This resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its adoption.
